ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF
AND APPROVING MODIFICATION ONE

(Issued August 21, 2015)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is set to expire September 1, 2015.¹ The Postal Service filed a motion for temporary relief and notice of filing Modification One to the Existing Agreement extending the expiration date.²

The Postal Service expects to initiate a new rate docket, in which the Postal Service would file the successor to the agreement that is the subject of this docket.

In its Motion, the Postal Service states the expiration date is August 31, 2015. *Id.* at 1.

Motion at 1. In order to maintain continuity of pricing and other terms and conditions of the Existing Agreement, the Postal Service requests that the Commission grant a brief extension. *Id.* at 2. Attached to the Motion is Modification One which the customer and the Postal Service have executed. Modification One provides that the agreement that is the subject of this docket will expire on September 30, 2015, thereby eliminating the earlier potential termination date. *Id.*, Attachment 1.

The Motion is granted. The Existing Agreement is modified to continue through, and will expire on September 30, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement. Temporary relief and modification of the Existing Agreement is in the public interest and will not prejudice any person.

It is ordered:

1. The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Temporary Relief, filed August 20, 2015, is granted.
2. The Commission approves the existing Global Expedited Package Services 3 negotiated service agreement, as modified.
