ORDER APPROVING MODIFICATION ONE TO GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE  
SERVICES 3 NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT

(Issued September 16, 2015)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is set to expire on September 30, 2015.<sup>1</sup> The Postal Service filed a notice of filing Modification One to the Existing Agreement, which extends the expiration date.<sup>2</sup>

The Postal Service expects to initiate a new rate docket, in which the Postal Service would file the successor to the agreement that is the subject of this docket. Notice at 1. In order to maintain continuity of pricing and other terms and conditions of the Existing Agreement, the Postal Service requests that the Commission grant a brief extension. *Id.* at 2. Attached to the Notice is Modification One, which the customer and

the Postal Service have executed. Modification One provides that the agreement that is the subject of this docket will expire on October 31, 2015, thereby eliminating the earlier potential termination date. *Id.* Attachment 1.

Since modification of the Existing Agreement is in the public interest and will not prejudice any person, the Commission approves Modification One. The Existing Agreement is modified to continue through and will expire on October 31, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement.

*It is ordered:*

1. The United States Postal Service Modification One to a Global Expedited Package Services 3 Negotiated Service Agreement is approved.
2. The Existing Agreement will remain on the Mail Classification Schedule through October 31, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement.
