ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF

(Issued September 17, 2015)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is set to expire September 24, 2015.¹ The Postal Service filed a motion for temporary relief seeking to extend the expiration date of the Existing Agreement.²

The Postal Service expects to sign a new agreement with the customer in the coming week, which it will then file with the Commission. Motion at 1-2. To maintain continuity of the customer's access to negotiated rates with the Postal Service, the

Postal Service requests the Commission grant an extension to allow the Existing Agreement to remain in effect for 30 additional days. *Id.* at 2.

The Motion is granted. The expiration date of the Existing Agreement is modified to October 24, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement. Temporary relief is in the public interest and will not prejudice any person.

It is ordered:

1. The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Temporary Relief, filed September 16, 2015, is granted.
2. The Existing Agreement will expire October 24, 2015, or the day after the Commission completes its review of the new agreement, whichever occurs first.
