**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF**
(September 18, 2015)

In PRC Order No. 2679, issued August 25, 2015, the Commission granted the Postal Service's request for a temporary extension of the contract in the instant docket, until September 30, 2015. The Postal Service has today filed the successor agreement with the Commission in Docket Nos. MC2015-85 and CP2015-141, which will replace Parcel Select Contract 4. However, because of the timing of the regulatory process, there may be a brief window between the expiration of the existing contract in this docket and the effective date of the new contract, while the Commission completes its review.

To avoid this result, the Postal Service respectfully requests that the Commission grant an additional brief extension to allow the existing contract to remain in effect until such time as the Commission is able to complete its review of the new agreement. Thus, the proposed extension would only last for a finite and relatively short period of time. In conclusion, for the reasons discussed above, and in consideration of the customers' business continuity, the Postal Service hereby moves for temporary relief to

allow the existing contract to remain on the competitive products list until such time as the successor agreement is approved.
