Please provide all completed documentation in regard to the statistical systems and procedures necessary to implement the proposals in the Postal Service Plan (for example, the documentation developed by third parties for the Postal Service). For documentation that has not been completed, please identify the documentation and provide an estimate of when this documentation may be provided to the Commission.

RESPONSE

The Statistical Design Plan was filed in this docket on August 25, 2015. It contains the methodologies and functional requirements for First Mile and Last Mile sampling. The document also includes the methodology and formulas for calculating overall service performance scores, combining First Mile, processing duration, and Last Mile data. Finally, it outlines the targeted levels of statistical precision which drives the number of samples to be taken.
