ORDER SCHEDULING TECHNICAL CONFERENCE  
CONCERNING THE STATISTICAL DESIGN PLAN

(Issued September 28, 2015)

On August 25, 2015, the Postal Service filed the statistical design plan for its proposed service performance measurement systems for market dominant products.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission will host an off-the-record technical conference to discuss the statistical design plan on Wednesday, October 28, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., in the Commission's hearing room. The technical conference is open to all persons interested in the Postal Service's statistical design plan, and will be webcast on the Commission's website. The Postal Service will briefly outline the proposals contained within its plan, and be available to answer questions relating to the proposals.

The Postal Service also is developing an auditing plan for its proposed service performance measurement systems for market dominant products. The Postal Service will file a notice concerning the development and filing status of the auditing plan. After

the auditing plan is filed, the Commission will determine whether one or more additional technical conferences will be needed to answer questions concerning the plan.

The Commission will provide an opportunity for interested persons to comment on the statistical design plan and the auditing plan. The deadline for filing comments will be established at a later date.

*It is ordered:*

1. A technical conference will be held in the Commission's hearing room on October 28, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., where the Postal Service will briefly outline its statistical design plan, and be available to answer questions.
2. The Postal Service will file a notice concerning the development and filing status of the auditing plan by October 2, 2015.
