ORDER APPROVING MODIFICATION TWO
TO A GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES 3
NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT

(Issued October 20, 2015)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is scheduled to expire on October 31, 2015.¹ The Postal Service has filed a notice of its filing of Modification Two to the Existing Agreement, which extends the expiration date.²

The Postal Service states that it intends to initiate a new rate docket in which it will file a successor to the Existing Agreement. Notice at 1. To maintain continuity of

pricing and other terms and conditions of the Existing Agreement, the Postal Service requests the Commission to approve Modification Two, which provides that the agreement that is the subject of this docket will expire on November 30, 2015. *Id.* Attached to the Notice is Modification Two, which both the Postal Service and the customer have executed. *Id.* Attachment 1.

If Modification Two is approved, it will authorize the second extension of the expiration date of the agreement that is the subject of this docket. The first extension was granted by an order issued September 16, 2015. Order No. 2714, *supra*, n.1. That order extended the expiration date from September 30, 2015, to October 31, 2015. *Id.* at 2. Modification Two would extend the expiration date further to November 30, 2015. Notice at 2.

Modification Two does not affect the cost coverage or compliance with existing regulatory requirements for the Existing Agreement, and in the absence of harm to the public interest or prejudice to any party, the Commission approves Modification Two.

The Existing Agreement may continue through and will expire on November 30, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement.

It is ordered:

1. The United States Postal Service of Filing Modification Two to a Global Expedited Package Services 3 Negotiated Service Agreement, filed October 15, 2015, is approved.

2. The Existing Agreement will remain on the Mail Classification Schedule through November 30, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement.
