ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ACCESS  
TO MATERIALS FILED UNDER SEAL BY UNITED PARCEL SERVICE  
AND UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE

(Issued November 16, 2015)

In this proceeding, United Parcel Service, Inc. (UPS) filed certain materials under seal labeled as UPS-RM2016-2/LR-NP1.<sup>1</sup> Amazon Fulfillment Services, Inc. (Amazon) seeks access to the non-public materials filed by UPS for additional reviewing representatives, Ai Deng and Ben Mermelstein.<sup>2</sup> The Motion also seeks access by Ai

Deng and Ben Mermelstein to the non-public data in Docket No. RM2015-7.<sup>3</sup> In Order Nos. 2765 and 2810, the Commission granted the same access described above to Amazon and its representatives.<sup>4</sup> Amazon states its representative, T. Scott Thompson, has sought assistance from Ai Deng and Ben Mermelstein as part of this proceeding; therefore, both require access to materials previously made available to T. Scott Thompson. Motion at 1; see *also* Order No. 2810. Additionally, Amazon notes that UPS and the Postal Service do not oppose the request. Motion at 2.

The Commission grants Amazon's unopposed request for access by Ai Deng and Ben Mermelstein to the materials, and for access to the data made available in Docket No. RM2015-7.

*It is ordered:*

1. The Unopposed Motion of Amazon Fulfillment Services, Inc., for Access by Ai Deng and Ben Mermelstein to Materials Filed Under Seal by United Parcel Service, Inc. and United States Postal Service, filed November 16, 2015, is granted.
2. Ai Deng and Ben Mermelstein, as representatives of Amazon Fulfillment Services, Inc., may access the non-public library reference identified as UPS-RM2016-2/LR-NP1.
