ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF

(Issued November 23, 2015)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is scheduled to expire on November 30, 2015.¹ The Postal Service has filed a motion for temporary relief requesting extension of the expiration date to December 31, 2015.²

The Postal Service represents that it received a signed successor agreement on November 19, 2015, which it intends to file with the Commission in a new rate docket. Motion at 1. The Postal Service states that, due to “protracted negotiations,” it was unable to file a successor agreement with the Commission by the November 13, 2015,

filing deadline. *Id.* To maintain “continuity of pricing and other terms and conditions of the [Existing Agreement],” the Postal Service requests that the Commission approve an extension allowing the Existing Agreement to remain in effect and listed on the Mail Classification Schedule, through December 31, 2015. *Id.*

The Motion is granted. The Existing Agreement will remain in effect through, and will expire on, December 31, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement. Temporary relief extending the Existing Agreement is in the public interest and will not prejudice any person.

It is ordered:

1. The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Temporary Relief, filed November 20, 2015, is granted.
2. The Existing Agreement will remain in effect, and continue to be listed on the Mail Classification Schedule, through December 31, 2015, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms of the agreement.
