**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF
CONCERNING GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES 3
NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT**

(December 18, 2015)

The agreement that is the subject of this docket is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2015.¹ Protracted negotiations for this agreement have prevented the Postal Service from meeting its December 16, 2015 filing deadline. However, a signed renewal agreement was received and is being filed with the Commission in Docket CP2016-58 on December 18, 2015. Should the agreement that is the subject of this docket expire before the success agreement goes into effect, the Postal Service requests that the Commission continue to list the agreement that is the subject of this docket on the Mail Classification Schedule to maintain continuity of pricing and other terms and conditions of the agreement.

The Postal Service therefore asks that the agreement that is the subject of this docket be extended, if necessary, until the successor agreement filed goes into effect.
