ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO CHAIRMAN'S
INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 1 AND EXTENDING COMMENT DEADLINE

(Issued December 29, 2015)

The Postal Service seeks to add a new product identified as Priority Mail Contract 167 to the competitive product list.¹ On December 17, 2015, the Commission established January 7, 2016, as the date to submit comments in this docket.² On

December 18, 2015, CHIR No. 1 was issued to clarify the Postal Service's request and directed the Postal Service to respond by December 28, 2015.³

On December 28, 2015, the Postal Service filed a motion requesting to extend the deadline to respond to CHIR No. 1 to January 5, 2016.⁴ The Postal Service states that it will not be able to respond by December 28, 2015, because of "the holidays, the complexity of the requests, the obligation to file the Annual Compliance Report on December 29, and the absence during the next several days of key individuals needed to prepare responses." *Id.* at 1.

Because the requested extension will facilitate the development of a more complete record and will not prejudice any person, the Commission grants the Motion. To provide interested persons an opportunity to consider the response to CHIR No. 1 in their comments, the date to file comments is extended to January 12, 2016.

It is ordered:

1. The Postal Service Motion, filed December 28, 2015, is granted.
2. The Postal Service shall respond to CHIR No. 1 by January 5, 2016.
3. The Commission extends the date for filing comments from no later than January 5, 2016, to no later than January 12, 2016.
