**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
OF FILING FINANCIAL WORKPAPERS AND CERTIFIED STATEMENT**

On December 31, 2015, the United States Postal Service (Postal Service) filed in the docket listed above a notice of filing a functionally equivalent Global Reseller Expedited Package Services 2 negotiated service agreement.<sup>1</sup> The Postal Service includes with this notice the redacted financial workpapers and the certified statement required by 39 C.F.R. § 3015.5(c)(2) (Attachment 2) mentioned in footnote 8 on page 3 of the notice that the Postal Service filed on December 31, 2015, in this docket. In addition, the Postal Service is filing under seal the certified statement required by 39 C.F.R. § 3015.5(c)(2), and financial workpapers establishing compliance with 39 U.S.C. § 3633 and 39 C.F.R. § 3015.5.

The Postal Service incorporates by reference the application for non-public treatment that was filed in this docket in conjunction with the notice of the Postal Service dated December 31, 2015.<sup>2</sup> The application protects from disclosure the information that has been redacted from the additional materials that the Postal Service is filing publicly today with this notice.

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**Certification of Prices for the Global Reseller Expedited Package Contracts 2  
with [REDACTED]**

I, Steven Phelps, Manager, Regulatory Reporting and Cost Analysis, Finance Department, United States Postal Service, am familiar with the prices for the Global Reseller Expedited Package Contract with [REDACTED]. The prices contained in this Contract were established by the Decision of the Governors of the United States Postal Service on the Establishment of Prices and Classifications for Domestic Competitive Agreements, Outbound International Competitive Agreements, Inbound International Competitive Agreements, and Other Non-Published Competitive Rates, issued March 22, 2011 (Governors' Decision No. 11-6), which established prices by means of price floor formulas.

I hereby certify that the numerical cost values underlying the prices in the [REDACTED] contract are the appropriate costs to use in the formulas and represent the best available information. The prices, resulting in a cost coverage of in excess of the minimum required by the Governors' Decision, exclusive of pickup on demand and international ancillary services fees, are in compliance with 39 U.S.C § 3633 (a)(1), (2), and (3). The prices demonstrate that the Contract should cover its attributable costs and preclude the subsidization of competitive products by market dominant products. International competitive mail accounts for a relatively small percentage of the total contribution by all competitive products. Contribution from Global Reseller Expedited Package Contracts should be even smaller. The Agreement with [REDACTED] should not impair the ability of competitive products on the whole to cover an appropriate share of institutional costs.
