CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 6

(Issued January 28, 2016)

The Postal Service notified the Commission that it intends to expand the Customized Delivery market test to the following metropolitan areas: Sacramento, CA; Stamford, CT; and Las Vegas, NV.¹ To facilitate the Commission's evaluation of the expansion, the Postal Service is requested to provide written responses to the following requests. Responses should be provided to each request as soon as they are developed, but no later than February 5, 2016.

In accordance with Order No. 2224,² please provide the following information for each metropolitan area listed above:

1. Examples of businesses that offer similar products or services.
2. The range of prices these businesses charge for similar products and services.
3. A description of the impact of the expansion on small business concerns.³
