**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF FILING
REVENUE COLLECTION REPORT FOR QUARTER 1 OF FISCAL YEAR 2016**
(February 16, 2016)

In accordance with Order No. 2075, issued on May 2, 2014,¹ the Postal Service hereby submits its report on the amount of exigent surcharge revenue collected for the quarter ending December 31, 2015 (“Revenue Collection Report” or “Report”).² As set forth in the Report filed with this pleading, the Postal Service collected \$570.1 million in exigent surcharge revenue in Quarter 1 of Fiscal Year 2016. The Postal Service has collected \$4.090 billion in cumulative surcharge revenue since implementation of the exigent surcharge.
