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**REQUEST:**

Please refer to § I.B. of the redacted version of the Amendment provided with this Notice. The Postal Service redacted information from public view concerning the product being added to the existing agreement. Does the Postal Service consider the product offered to qualify for non-public treatment under 39 C.F.R. part 3007? If so, please provide a basis for that assertion. If not, please file an errata removing this redaction.

**RESPONSE:**

The redacted information in § I.B. of the Amendment pertains to the weight limit for eligible packages shipped under this contract. The Postal Service considers the weight limit to be commercially sensitive information for this contract, as it has with all other negotiated service agreements. Nevertheless, to further clarify, this Amendment does not specifically exclude Parcel Select Lightweight packages from the definition in § I.B., as they were excluded in the original contract language.
