**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LEAVE TO REPLY TO
COMMENTS OF UNITED PARCEL SERVICE**
(April 28, 2016)

The United States Postal Service moves for leave to respond to the comments filed by the United Parcel Service (UPS) in this docket on April 19, 2016. In its comments, UPS asserts that the GeM Merchant Solution market test will cause market disruption and should either be rejected by the Commission or classified as Market Dominant. The Postal Regulatory Commission established a deadline of April 19, 2016, for comments on the proposed GeM Merchant Solution Market Test, but did not establish a period in which parties could respond to comments. The Postal Service response that is the subject of this motion aims to address arguments presented by UPS that were not yet raised in earlier submissions and will assist the Commission in assessing the issues presented in this docket.

The Postal Service respectfully requests that the Commission grant this motion, and consider the reply comments of the Postal Service that will be provided in response to the UPS Comments.
