ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

(Issued June 14, 2016)

On March 17, 2016, Marlene Roe (Petitioner) filed a petition with the Commission seeking review of the Postal Service's decision to close the Westbrookville, New York post office.¹

On June 1, 2016, the Postal Service filed a motion asking to dismiss the proceedings as moot.² The Postal Service explains that it has entered into an extension of the supplier contract, which allowed service at the Westbrookville post office to continue through May 31, 2016. On May 31, 2016, a permanent contract with a new

supplier was executed to provide continued service to the community. At no point was the Westbrookville post office closed.

The Postal Service's Motion is unopposed. The Petition is dismissed as moot.

It is ordered:

The United States Postal Service Motion to Dismiss Proceedings as Moot, filed June 1, 2016, is granted.
