**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF
CONCERNING GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES
NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT**
(June 23, 2016)

The agreement that is the subject of this docket is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2016.¹ A signed renewal agreement, which is intended to go into effect, if possible, on July 1, 2016, was filed with the Commission in Docket CP2016-225 on June 20, 2016.² The possibility exists that the agreement that is the subject of this docket might expire before the successor agreement filed in Docket No. CP2016-225 goes into effect.

The Postal Service has sent a modification to the customer that states that the agreement that is the subject of this docket will expire on the sooner of (1) June 30, 2016, if the Commission completes its review of the successor agreement filed in Docket No. CP2016-225 by June 30, 2016; or (2) the business day after the Commission completes its review of the successor agreement,

In the meantime, however, the Postal Service requests that the Commission approve a brief extension of the agreement that is the subject of this docket, to maintain

continuity of pricing and other terms and conditions of the agreement. The Postal Service requests that the Commission continue to list the agreement that is the subject of this docket on the Mail Classification Schedule until the sooner of (1) June 30, 2016, if the Commission completes its review of the successor agreement filed in Docket No. CP2016-225 by June 30, 2016; or (2) the business day after the Commission completes its review of the successor agreement, thereby replacing the earlier potential termination date that the Postal Service filed in this docket.
