REDACTED AMENDMENT TO PRIORITY MAIL CONTRACT 186

**AMENDMENT OF
SHIPPING SERVICES CONTRACT
BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
AND
[REDACTED]
REGARDING PRIORITY MAIL SERVICE**

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service (“the Postal Service”) and [REDACTED] (“Customer”) entered into a shipping services contract regarding Priority Mail outbound service on December 28, 2015.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend Section I.F under this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the contract is hereby amended as detailed below. The existing contract remains unchanged in all other respects. This amendment shall become effective one business day following the day on which the Commission issues all necessary regulatory approval.

[Replace Section I.F in its entirety, as follows:]

I. Terms

- F. From the effective date of the contract until December 31, 2016 (“Implementation Period”), as outlined in Table 1, Customer will receive the Tier 3 SSC pricing for Priority Mail Contract Packages, pursuant to Table 5 below. Customer will be exempt from the minimum average defined in Table 2 during the Implementation Period. After the Implementation Period, Customer shall mail a minimum of [REDACTED] Total Packages (Contract Packages plus all other Priority Mail packages) during each Contract Quarter for the term of this contract. If the volume falls below the [REDACTED] quarterly average, the Postal Service at its sole discretion has the right to revert Customer to the most current Commercial Plus prices.
