**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its responses to Questions 3-6 and 8-10 of Chairman's Information Request (CHIR) No. 7, which was issued on July 14, 2016.
