ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF  
AND APPROVING MODIFICATION ONE

(Issued September 23, 2016)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is set to expire on September 30, 2016.<sup>1</sup> On September 22, 2016, the Postal Service filed a combined motion for temporary relief and notice of filing a modification (Modification One) to the Existing Agreement.<sup>2</sup>

The Postal Service filed a successor agreement in Docket No. CP2016-288 with an intended effective date of October 1, 2016.<sup>3</sup> As it is possible the Existing Agreement may expire before the successor is approved, the Postal Service requests that the Commission grant a brief extension and continue to list the Existing Agreement in the Mail Classification Schedule pending Commission approval of the successor filed in Docket No. CP2016-288. Motion at 1-2; *see also id.* Attachment 1 at 1.

The Commission grants the Motion and approves Modification One. Allowing the Existing Agreement to remain in effect temporarily is in the public interest and will not prejudice any person. The Existing Agreement will expire on its original expiration date of September 30, 2016, if the Commission completes its review in Docket No. CP2016-288 prior to that date. If the Commission is unable to complete its review in Docket No. CP2016-288 by September 30, 2016, the Existing Agreement is authorized to continue until the Commission completes its review or October 31, 2016, whichever occurs sooner.

*It is ordered:*

1. The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Temporary Relief, filed September 22, 2016, is granted.
2. The Commission approves Modification One, filed by the Postal Service on September 22, 2016.
