**MOTION OF THE UNITED PARCEL SERVICE, INC. FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF
FILING OF COMMENTS IN RESPONSE TO RM2016-13
(October 17, 2016)**

United Parcel Service, Inc. (“UPS”) hereby moves the Postal Regulatory Commission (“PRC”) to accept its Comments in Docket No. RM2016-13 that were filed by UPS less than forty-five minutes after the 4:30 pm filing deadline on October 17, 2016. Due, in part, to technical difficulties UPS experienced with the PRC’s website in connection with a separate PRC filing (*i.e.* RM2016-12), UPS was unable to timely file its Comments in this docket.¹ UPS ultimately filed its Comments at 4:37 pm, but was subsequently directed to refile its Comments with this accompanying Motion for Late Acceptance. UPS does not consider that any party will be prejudiced by the filing of its late comments. Accordingly, UPS requests that this Motion be granted and that the PRC accept UPS’s Comments.
