REGARDING UNITED PARCEL SERVICE'S MOTION FOR
ACCESS

(October 18 , 2016)

United Parcel Service, Inc. ("UPS") and the United States Postal Service ("Postal Service") respectfully submit this Joint Status Report in response to the Commission's Order Granting Motion For Access To Non-Public Materials Filed Under Seal. On October 11, 2016, the Commission granted UPS' Motion for Access on the condition that the UPS and the Postal Service file an executed agreement regarding inadvertent disclosure within five days of the order. To the extent the parties were unable to reach an agreement within that time period, the Commission directed the parties to file a status report apprising the Commission of the status of the negotiations. To date, despite good faith negotiations, parties have not yet executed an agreement regarding inadvertent disclosure. However, the parties have exchanged drafts and will continue to negotiate in good faith. The parties are hopeful that an agreement can be reached in short order. The parties will update the Commission by Friday, October 21, 2016 at the latest.
