The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is filing the following Category 6 Library Reference with the Commission:

USPS-LR-PI2015-1/8 USPS Service Performance Measurement Plan¹

This Library Reference represents the Postal Service's third revision to the proposed internal measurement system for market dominant products in this docket. The original proposed measurement system is reflected in Library Reference PRC-LR-PI2015-1/1, which accompanied PRC Order No. 2336 (January 29, 2015).² The Postal Service subsequently filed revisions to the Plan on March 3, 2015³ and March 24, 2015.⁴ The replacement filed today includes additional revisions to the proposed internal service performance measurement (SPM) system.
